

Appointment of new Principal Investigators (PIs)

The MacDiarmid Institute for Advanced Materials and Nanotechnology

The MacDiarmid Institute invites applications for new Principal Investigators (PIs).

Selection criteria:

- Research Excellence. This will in part be demonstrated by your supplied CV; we ask you to provide specific detail of the relevance of key metrics to your proposed contributions to the MacDiarmid Institute on this form. A brief statement of the impact of your research, in particular where it relates to community engagement or policy implementation, may also be useful evidence here.
- Strategic Engagement. All Principal Investigators must, in addition to demonstrating Research Excellence, contribute in some way to the Outreach, Engagement, and Commercialisation activities of the Institute (the 'non-science plan'). A CoRE is a team, so we do NOT expect all members of the institute to contribute in the same way: creating a start-up, engagement with Māori communities, or leadership of institute outreach programmes are all examples of valuable contributions.
- As the MacDiarmid Institute is a team, we look for evidence of achievement on both Research Excellence and Strategic Engagement relative to opportunity.

Eligibility:

Applicant must be New Zealand-based and will normally be employed by one of the MacDiarmid Institute partner organisations.

Process:

Please submit an application online via this website. It will need to include:

- Research CV in either the MBIE RS&T or narrative templates
- Proposed topic and project outline for PhD scholarship
- Two letters of support from current Principal Investigators

Applications will be considered by the MacDiarmid Institute's review panel and must be received by no later than 5pm on Monday 3rd February 2025.
